Today's challenges also open up great opportunities for Blue Growth startups, active in different sectors such as aquaculture, blue biotechnology or related topics.

Accelerator for Blue Growth, connecting more than 1,000 experts and over 70 scientific institutions, is giving a significant boost for unlocking this potential in the Baltic Sea Region (BSR) – with its help innovative ideas are turned into new products or services.

In the European context, Blue Growth and the Blue Economy are becoming increasingly important concepts that influence many economic and social mechanisms and receive a great attention from policy makers on national and regional level. Regulatory mechanisms seek to prevent the reckless exploitation of natural resources, but at the same time, the region seeks to stimulate industries that might identify new business niches, create high value and new jobs.

Societies here already understood the importance of a sustainable economy and industries are hungry for biobased innovations, opening new avenues for blue bioeconomy while contributing at the same time to improvement of environmental conditions of the Baltic Sea.

Accelerator for Blue Growth is operated by SUBMARINER Network, a hub promoting sustainable use of marine resources. The platform is coordinated by partners from the Baltic Sea Region countries (Sweden, Finland, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Germany, Denmark), who have an extensive network of contacts with all BSR universities, research institutes and laboratories, working in the fields related to Blue Growth. A pool of mentors ecompasses scientific and commercial experts.

In addition to the well-developed scientific research bases, the Baltic Sea Region has an extensive network of business support institutions. It is much easier to access important financial assistance mechanisms and potential investors through the Accelerator for Blue Growth, so the outreach of the involved startups is more efficient – from Berlin to Klaipeda, from Stockholm – to Hamburg, Helsinki, Tallinn, Riga or Copenhagen.
